### II. Development of the UNRBA Decision Framework – Part 1— Facilitated Session

Item Summary (Amy Shahar): The UNRBA will begin discussing its Decision Framework for the Reexamination. The October PFC meeting will focus four different categories of decisions – minor, normal, major, and critical; the level of decision-making authority the UNRBA should seek for each category; members' access to their home organizations leaders; areas where access to leadership should be strengthened; and actionable opportunities to make improvements. III. UNRBA Alternative Implementation Approach – A Prospective Framework — Informational Item
